
# Seas and Oceans fundamental for Europe's prosperity

Maritime Economy	5 % of EU's GDP 5 million jobs
Coastal regions	40% of EU's GDP
Maritime transport	90% of external trade 40% of internal trade
Fisheries and aquaculture	0,7 million jobs 30 billion € annually
Tourism	3 million jobs 72 billion € of revenue
Renewable energy	121 millions € (2005)
New resources and blue biotechnology	10% growth annually? Global market 2,4 billion €
