SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1928. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly be submitted.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1928 comprised 3,105 sailing vessels, 1,934 motor vessels, 820 steam drifters, 3 steam mussel dredgers, 40 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 314 steam trawlers, or a total of 6,216 vessels, valued with their gear at £3,891,762, as against 6,399 vessels and £3,920,586 in 1927. In addition 255 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 25,043 (of whom 6,345 were crofter fishermen and 937 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 25,677 (including 6,436 crofter fishermen and 1,002 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 66,676, as against 67,471 in 1927.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 6,603,770 cwts., valued at £4,658,100, besides shell-fish valued at £97,974, as against 6,919,920 cwts., £4,369,968 and £93,421 respectively in 1927. In addition 729,448 cwts., valued at £431,657, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 786,976 cwts. and £370,936 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 7,333,218 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £5,187,731, as compared with 7,706,296 cwts. and £4,834,325 in 1927. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 4,011,224 cwts., valued at £1,824,066 against 4,235,467 cwts. and £1,746,922.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 1,135,778 barrels (of which 959,963 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £2,764,603, against a total of 1,171,757 barrels valued at £2,709,473 in 1927. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 625,344 cwts., valued at £1,235,573, as against 543,664 cwts. and £1,065,667 in 1927.

The exports of fish from Scotland comprised 954,974 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, 1,169 barrels ungutted, and 141,097 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 987,956 barrels, 6,127 barrels, and 193,140 crans respectively in 1927, and 334,510 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of other kinds, and 16,654 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 318,310 cwts. and 16,579 cwts. respectively in 1927.
