




Focal Points

Focal Points Focal Points are national and regional representatives that work with the database experts in building the quantity and quality of information in the databases.

[This includes data on vernacular names, species occurrence, legal instruments and local expertise (e.g. experts, journals, societies, collections)].



PESI is working towards the geographic expansion of the European networks of experts to cover the entire Palaearctic biogeographic region, beginning with Turkey, Georgia, Ukraine and Russia.

Focal Points also assist in the **cross-validation of national and pan-European taxonomic checklists**, ensuring that national checklist custodians are involved in the standardisation process and therefore promoting taxonomic standards throughout Europe.

This is of direct importance for national government bodies concerned with the implementation of, for instance, legislation (referring to species).

Information gathered from the Focal points is made available to a European audience either on the PESI web portal and/or through links between the pan-European and national portals.
